

## EncounterPRO Foundation, Inc. Contributor Agreement

These terms apply to your Contribution to a Project known as The EncounterPRO Open Source Project (the "Project") which is managed by The EncounterPRO Foundation, Inc. ("EncounterPRO Foundation"), a non-profit Georgia corporation whose purpose is 1) to manage the EncounterPRO Open Source Project, 2) to promote the use of open source EMR/EHR software, and 3) to promote the open source EncounterPRO-OS EMR Clinical Groupware Platform ("Foundation Purposes").

. This Agreement sets out the intellectual property rights you grant to us in your Contribution. If this Contribution is on behalf of a company, the term "you" also means the company you identify below. If you agree to be bound by these terms, fill in the information requested below and provide your signature. Read this agreement carefully before signing.

1. "Contribution" means any source code, object code, script, patch, tool, sample, video, audio, graphic, specification, manual, documentation, or any other material posted or submitted by you to the Project or otherwise submitted by you to The EncounterPRO Foundation.
2. Except as set out below you keep all right, title, and interest in your Contribution. The rights you grant to us under these terms are effective on the date you first submitted a Contribution to us, even if your submission took place before the date you sign these terms. The EncounterPRO Foundation will only make your Contribution available under one or more of the following licenses:

- GNU Affero General Public License (version 3 or later) (the "AGPL")

- The APGL with the following exception (the "APGL with Independent Component Exception"):

The copyright holders of EncounterPRO Open Source Project give you permission to link the Project with independent components, regardless of the license terms of these independent components, provided that all of the following are true:

- all access from the independent component to persisted data which resides inside any EncounterPRO Open Source data store (e.g. SQL Server database) be made through a publically available database driver (e.g. ODBC, SQL Native Client, etc) or through a service which itself is part of The Project;
- the independent component does not create or rely on any code or data structures within the EncounterPRO Open Source data store unless such code or data structures, and all code and data structures referred to by such code or data structures, are themselves part of The Project; and
- the independent component either a) runs locally on the user's computer, or b) is linked to at runtime by The Project's Component Manager object which in turn is called by code which itself is part of The Project.

An independent component is a component which is not derived from or based on the Project. If you modify the Project, you may extend this additional permission to your version of the Project, but you are not obligated to do so. If you do not wish to do so, delete this additional permission statement from your version.

- Any future FSF (Free Software Foundation) or OSI (Open Source Initiative) approved license that is substantially identical to the AGPL with Independent Component Exception; and
- Creative commons attribution-share-alike license (Version 3 or later) for materials other than software.

3. With respect to any world-wide copyrights, or copyright applications and registrations in your Contribution:

- you hereby assign to us joint ownership (which joint ownership we may assign in furtherance of Foundation Purposes) and to the extent such assignment is or becomes invalid, ineffective, or unenforceable, you grant to us a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, world-wide, no charge, royalty-free, sublicensable, unrestricted license to exercise all rights under those copyrights;
- you agree that for the purpose of using your Contribution or enforcing the copyright thereto, each of us can do all things in relation to your Contribution as if each of us were the sole owners, and if one of us makes a derivative work of your Contribution, the one who makes the derivative work (or has it made) will be the sole owner of that derivative work;
- you agree that you will not assert any moral rights in your Contribution against us, our licensees or transferees;
- you agree that we may register a copyright in your Contribution and exercise all ownership rights associated with it; and
- you agree that neither of us has any duty to consult with, obtain the consent of, pay or render an accounting to the other for any use or distribution of your Contribution.

4. With respect to any patents applicable to the Contribution that you own, or that you can license without payment to any third party, you hereby grant to us a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, world-wide, no-charge, royalty-free,

sublicensable license to make, have made, use, sell, offer to sell, import, and otherwise transfer your Contribution (or copyright derivatives thereof) in whole or in part, alone or in combination with or included in any product, work or materials arising out of the Project to which your Contribution was submitted.

5. With respect to your Contribution, you represent that

- it is an original work and that you can legally grant the rights set out in this Agreement;
- it does not to the best of your knowledge violate any third party's copyrights, trademarks, patents, or other intellectual property rights; and
- if you work for a company and your company has any interest in the code that you write, you are authorized as its agent or employee to sign this Agreement on behalf of your company.

6. These terms will be governed by the laws of the State of Georgia and, if applicable, U.S. federal law. Any choice of law rules will not apply. Any action regarding this agreement shall be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction in Cobb County, Georgia or in the Northern District of Georgia, or if the corporate headquarters of The EncounterPRO Foundation are relocated, in the county or federal district where The EncounterPRO Foundation maintains such headquarters.
